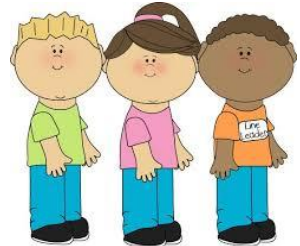


Camp Out
